"What is Tithing?"

Imagine you are enveloped like a cocoon surrounding you with warmth and light. Your core is reabsorbing all of your life's experiences. We are made of star stuff – you are matter being re-collected and re-absorbed. You are encapsulated in this sacred space that has morphed into the YOU that you are, and that which you present on your Earth walk.

When we tithe, it unlocks that of us in the spirit realm. Not only does giving of your coin (which is the tangible expression of what you've collected and now release, to be used to enhance and make better the lives of others), to that which gives you joy. It aligns you with the causes that matter to you. It generates contentment in your heart. It validates you, and you make yourself the validation by gifting what you have absorbed in your life, what you've made of those experiences, and how you release *you*, out. You are the ultimate decision-maker of where your outpouring goes.

We serve multiplicity that honors the principles of generosity by 3 kinds of giving;

- 1. Tithing (the foundation of giving)
- 2. Offerings (are for specific needs example, missions, buildings, etc.)
- 3. Alms (for the poor)

We tithe to that which fills our soul, brings us joy, teaches us timeless principles, 10% to the source of our spiritual sustenance (where you have been spiritually fed). Our Center does great work and we support that by changing lives, creating a more connected world, and it raises the benefit of others. Through our acts of unselfish giving, we attune our consciousness to that of universal abundance.

The biggest deterrent to giving is fear that if we give away too much, we won't have enough. That of lack, which we know in OUR beliefs is not the consciousness we embrace.
